English:

In the Spring term, Year 4 will still follow the talk for writing scheme and this half term we will be inventing our own portal story and writing a discussion text. The writing links in with our Globe Trotting topic theme for this term. We will continue the Year 4 spelling objectives as part of English lessons as well as learning individual spellings.

Maths:

We will be furthering our learning including mastery of multiplication and division. We shall also be learning about area, fractions and decimals. It is essential that children continue to master their knowledge of multiplication facts (up to and including 12 x tables). Children are tested weekly on these.

Geography Topic:

This term's topic is Globe Trotting. We will be learning about the physical geography of the world's continents and oceans. We will also be developing our map reading skills.

Science:

This term, we will continue to develop our skills of working scientifically through the topics of sound and animals, including humans.

RE:

In RE, we are learning about the wisdom of King Solomon and The Book of Proverbs.

Art:

We will be looking at the works of great artists from around the world.

Music: The children are learning about musical notation and will learn and sing familiar songs.

Computing:

This term the children will be using a range of software to produce a website using HTML. They will also take part in Safer Internet Day.

DT:

We will be designing and creating a model of a healthy airline meal.

Other points:

PE: This will remain on Wednesday and either Tuesday or Friday, depending on which class your child is in.

Please ensure all PE kit is named including their school uniform.

Your child should have a named water bottle each day with them.

Reading records (signed by parents) and reading at least 5 times a week.

Homework goes home on a Friday and should be back in school on a Wednesday.
